







The Way of Salvation is a display of electro-art sculptures. A total of over a million tiny bulbs sparkle and flare, surrounding you in a beautiful dream of the Christmas season. This half mile route displays certain important events of the History of Salvation according to both the Old and New Testaments. The tour is fun for all ages as the lights move to show Jonah being swallowed by a whale, baby Moses floating downstream and parting the Red Sea as an adult, and David defeating Goliath with a slingshot. The display will give you a broad view of the generous saving act of God.




Noah's Ark
